COP28: A Global Climate Summit

- 28th session of the Conference of the Parties (COP) under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
- A forum for nations to collaborate on climate change mitigation, adaptation, and green transition
- The world's only multilateral decision-making forum on climate change
- Representatives of 197 countries participate primarily through debates and negotiations

COP1 in 1995
Pivotal in shaping global climate policy.

Kyoto Protocol (COP3) & Paris Agreement (COP21) have set the foundation for current climate action.

No COP will save the planet!

A moment of truth for the oil & gas sector

The oil and gas sector needs to cut its emissions by 60% by 2030* to align with the Paris goal of limiting global warming to 1.5°C

In 2022, the clean energy investments accounted for 2.5% of the industry's total capital spending.

Producers need to allocate 50% of capital expenditure toward clean energy projects by 2030, according to the Paris-based agency.

Key discussion points and agreements

- Loss and Damage Fund
- The Emirates Declaration on Sustainable Agriculture, Resilient Food Systems and Climate Action
- COP28 Declaration on Climate and Health, endorsed by over 120 countries Alterra fund to bridge global climate finance gap
- Launch of the Oil & Gas Decarbonization Charter (OGDC). 50 oil companies representing ~ 50% of global production pledged to reach near-zero methane emissions by 2030
- Pledge to phase out SF6
- The Biden administration unveiled final methane standards for existing oil and natural gas equipment
